## Plant fact sheet

### New Guinea Impatiens



<b>Plant type</b>	<b>Annual 40cm</b>
<b>Position</b>	<b>Sun / shade</b>
<b>Soil</b>	<b>Rich well drained</b>
<b>Water</b>	<b>Keep moist</b>
<b>Fertiliser</b>	<b>Liquid feed every two weeks</b>
<b>Other</b>	<b>Protect from frost and hot sun</b>

### Pennisetum setaceum Rubrum



<b>Plant type</b>	<b>Perennial 1m x 1m</b>
<b>Position</b>	<b>Sun</b>
<b>Soil</b>	<b>Well drained</b>
<b>Water</b>	<b>Occasionally, once dried out. Drought tolerant</b>
<b>Fertiliser</b>	<b>Slow release granular in spring</b>

## Plant fact sheet

### Sedum japonica 'Tokyo Sun'



<b>Plant type</b>	<b>Perennial groundcover</b>
<b>Position</b>	<b>Sun / part shade</b>
<b>Soil</b>	<b>Any, well drained</b>
<b>Water</b>	<b>Weekly, once dried out</b>
<b>Fertiliser</b>	<b>Slow release granular in spring</b>

### Senecio cineraria 'Silver Dust'



<b>Plant type</b>	<b>Perennial 30cm</b>
<b>Position</b>	<b>Sun / part shade</b>
<b>Soil</b>	<b>Well drained</b>
<b>Water</b>	<b>Occasionally, once dried out. Drought tolerant</b>
<b>Fertiliser</b>	<b>Slow release granular in spring</b>
