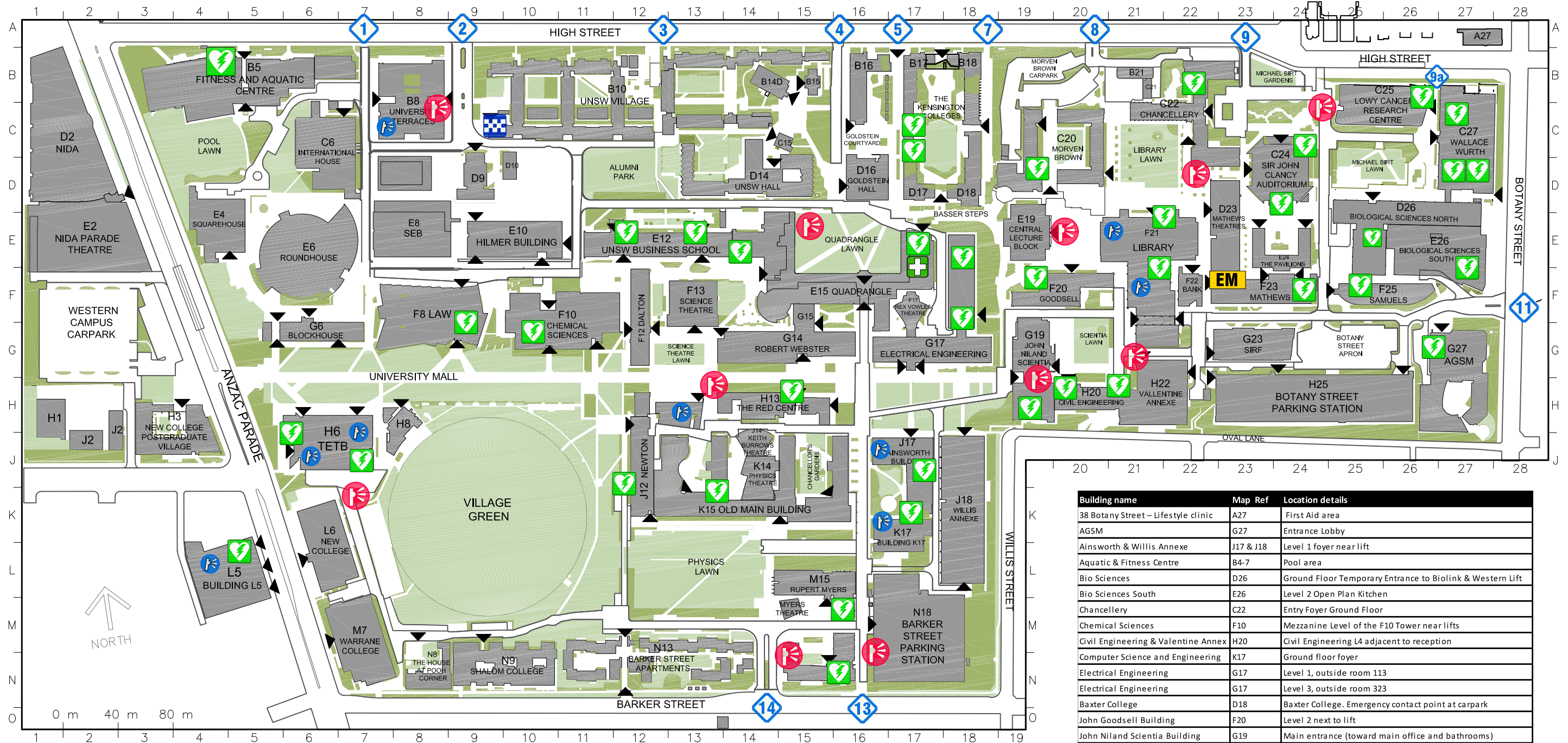

Use of Defibrillators

A Defibrillator should be applied whenever Sudden Cardiac Arrest is suspected, regardless of the time frame involved as it may increase the survival rate. The Defibrillator makes a diagnosis and provides useful information and instruction, via a synthesized voice, based on the condition of the patient and will only administer treatment if required.

Role of UNSW Security Services
